In order to receive special services:

- 1) Students with learning disabilities must send a copy of a relatively recent (within the past 3 years) psycho-educational assessment to the SDO directly. If you have sent this information to the Admissions Office, please fill in the Consent Form and mail it to the address indicated below. This will allow the SDO coordinator access to your psycho-educational information. The SDO will keep all information in the strictest confidence.
- 2) Make an appointment with the Coordinator of the SDO as soon as possible to work out an individual service plan.
