

PROVIDING PROOF OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

All applicants must provide proof of English proficiency regardless of citizenship/immigration status in Canada. Please identify the entry below that best describes your situation in order to determine what, if any, additional supporting documentation you must provide with your application for admission:

- Completed/completing a DEC at an English CEGEP in Quebec

Document required: Quebec permanent code

- Completed Secondary V in Quebec AND completed/completing a DEC at a French CEGEP in Quebec

Documents required: High school transcript AND
Quebec permanent code

- Completed the last four years of high school studies in Quebec, including Secondary V, at least two years ago

Document required: High school transcript

- Completed/completing at least three years of instruction at an accredited secondary institution, recognized by Bishop's University, where English is the primary language of instruction

Document required: High school transcript from the institution where English is the primary language of instruction

- Completed/completing four full years of study in Canada in French at the secondary-school level immediately prior to graduating

Document required: High school transcript

- Completed/completing at least 30 credit hours (or equivalent) at a post-secondary institution, recognized by Bishop's University, where English is the primary language of instruction

Document required: Transcript of studies from the post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction

- Completed/completing International Baccalaureate (IB) Group 1 English (Language A: Literature, Language A: Language and Literature, or Literature and Performance) with a final or predicted result of 6 or better

Document required: Final IB results statement OR
High school transcript showing predicted IB grades

- Completed/completing British Curriculum A-Level English with a final or predicted grade of C or better

Document required: Final A-level results report OR
High school transcript showing predicted A-Level grades

- Completed British Curriculum GCSE / IGCSE / GCE O-Level English, English Language, English First Language, or English as a Second Language with a final grade of B or better

Document required: Final GCSE / IGCSE / GCE O-Level results statement

- Completed a recognized English assessment with appropriate minimum score:

- TOEFL minimum overall score of 237 (computer-based) or 90 (Internet-based)
- IELTS minimum overall score of 6.5
- MELAB minimum overall score of 85
- CAEL minimum overall score of 70
- Cambridge English: Proficiency (CPE) minimum score of C
- Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE) minimum score of C
- Pearson Test of English: Academic (PTE: Academic) minimum overall score of 61

Document required: Official English assessment score report sent to Bishop's University directly from the testing organization
