### ELIGIBILITY

- You are a current full-time student from Bishop's University? (12 credits during the winter semester/opened to students from all academic programs)
- You are looking to gain valuable real-world experience and help a local organization?

### HOW THE *DESJARDINS ESTRIE-PRENEUR INTERNSHIP PROGRAM* WORKS?

- Students apply for this *internships program* by describing their experience and interests;
- Eight students will be selected and will form 4 teams. Each team will be paired with a local organization based on the needs of the company and the skills of the students;
- Each team of 2 students will **work full-time**, with one company during the 8 weeks of the internship (**Monday, April 29<sup>th</sup> to Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024**);
- The student's teams will be supervised, monitored and mentored throughout the project by Mr. Vincent Cloutier, a seasoned consultant and Contract Faculty at The Williams School of Business;
- The program is financed by Desjardins and set up by Bishop's University.

# STUDENTS: HOW TO APPLY?

Interested Bishop's University students must provide the following **three (3) documents**:

1. **a letter of interest**;
2. **a recent CV**;
3. **transcript or unofficial transcript** from the Registrar's Office at Bishop's University.

Students must describe in a letter their areas of expertise, their field of interest and their degree of fluency in written and spoken English and French, and if they have access to a vehicle.

All application documents for the program must be sent, **by e-mail, to Vincent Cloutier at Bishop's University: [vincent.cloutier@ubishops.ca](mailto:vincent.cloutier@ubishops.ca) no later than FRIDAY, MARCH 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2024 at NOON.**

Students must be available to **work full-time** on location on the project from **Monday, April 29<sup>th</sup> to Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024**, inclusive (8 weeks). Each of the selected students will receive a total **bursary of \$5000**, payable during the course of the project. The selected students will be notified by March 15, 2024, at the latest.

Please note that a selection committee will review and evaluate all applications in order to find the best possible match between companies and students. As this is a competitive process, not all applicants can be selected.

A total of only 4 companies and 8 students will be selected.

All applicants, whether selected or not, will be contacted to inform them of the results of the selection process.
