Biographical sketch:

Gérard Gardner, Ph.D. (1897 – 1988) from Acton Vale, Quebec was a Professor at the Universté de Montreal. He retired in 1981. At Bishop's University he established the Bélanger-Gardner Fund to support research pertaining to the Eastern Townships. Dr. Gardner also donated a large number of books, photos, etc. to Bishop's University. The books in question, the Bélanger-Gardner Collection, were placed in what was then the Laurie Allison Room in the John Bassett Memorial Library and continue to figure in Bishop's Special Collections. The Bélanger-Gardner Foundation has funds available to individuals, groups or associations for research on topics related to the Eastern Townships.
