

Move-In Cheat Sheet

Move-In Day is **Saturday August 31st** and begins at **9:30 AM**. Our staff will not be ready to check you in prior to that time. They will be outside until **4:30 PM**. If you arrive after this time, head over to the Security Office located beside the Dining Hall, where you will be re-directed to the proper building.

1. Once you arrive on campus, head over to your assigned residence hall. There will be several people dressed in purple ready to point you in the right direction.
2. Check-in with your RA. They will help you sign your lease and other important documents. You can familiarize yourself with these documents on our website. You will receive your keys and be shown to your new home.
3. The second you get to your new room, fill out the yellow room check form. It's very important to state the condition of your room right when you move in, otherwise you risk getting charged for any damages that may occur. Please return it to the Residence Office, located at Paterson Hall within 24hours of your arrival.
4. If you weren't given a student ID upon your check-in, head over to the Residence Office, located at Paterson Hall. It's essential for many things on campus, so head over there as soon as you can.
5. While you pick up your student ID and return your yellow form, don't forget to pick up your mailbox key at the Residence Office, located at Paterson Hall.
6. Meet your RAs and fellow residents outside your respective Residence Hall at 4:30PM for some fun ice breakers! From there, you will head over to the Welcome BBQ at the Dewhurst Dining Hall Tent at 5:00PM (Parents and families are welcome!).
7. At 6:30PM, don't miss out on Bishop's first football game of the season, where you will cheer on the Gaiters with your new community. RAs will be providing some purple paint and guide you to the field. Make sure to wear your building T-shirt!
8. After the football game, stop by the dining hall for fun games and a sundae bar!
