We are seeking a teaching assistant (TA) for the course AGR174 Agricultural Practicum which is given on the Bishop's Educational Farm. The Educational Farm (www.ubishops.ca/farm) is an essential component of the SAFS program, serving as a laboratory for experiential learning, research and community outreach.

Job Description

The TA will assist the instructor with the delivery of AGR174. The TA will assist in preparing farm materials and tools and make them available for class sessions, they will make sure safety measures are followed by the class on the farm and provide individual guidance for students with challenges. The TA will also assist the instructor when field trips or guest sessions are planned. The TA must be present at each class session of the course.

- Farm experience (specifically in market gardening systems) is an asset
- Enrollment in SAFS is an asset and priority will be given to students having taken AGR174 previously
