The purpose of the Senate Research Committee (SRC) is to support, encourage, and develop research within the Bishop's University academic community. One particular task of the SRC is to hold open and objectively adjudicated competitions for the allocation of available funds. These funds are supplied mainly by the Bishop's Foundation, with some support from SSHRC. The SRC interacts with the Vice-Principal's Office in matters relating to the development of research.
