- One Dean
- ◆ Five faculty nominated by Senate Nominating Committee, two of whom must be from the Division of Natural Sciences and Mathematics
- One student actively involved in research named by the Students' Representative Council
- Vice-Principal Finance and Administration or delegate (non-voting)
- Director of Buildings and Grounds (non-voting)
