The Principal called the 572nd meeting of Senate to order at 7:04 p.m.

ITEM 572/1 APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The Agenda was approved as circulated with Item 5.5, Composition of the Academic Standing and Admissions Policy Committee being deferred to the next meeting of Senate.

ITEM 572/2 APPROVAL OF MINUTES

2.1 Minutes of the 571st meeting of Senate, September 15th 2015

Sunny Lau moved approval of the Minutes of the 571st Meeting of Senate subject to a correction to item 7.2.1.2. The title of the course should read 'GSL 582 Teaching English to Adults 3-3-0' rather than 'GSL 582 Building oral competencies'. Jean Manore seconded the motion.

The motion carried.

ITEM 572/3 COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE CHAIR

Rankings

The Principal informed Senators that The Globe and Mail ratings and Maclean's rankings have been released. He explained that a change in assessment criteria had likely affected Bishop's overall ranking in Maclean's, which dropped from 9th to 12th this year.

On a more positive note, Bishop's ranked first among undergraduate institutions in the student satisfaction category, and second in the *Do your professors know your name*? ranking. The Principal expressed his appreciation for all who have helped achieve these results.

Once the NSSE rankings are available, Dan Seneker will analyse all of the results and make recommendations as appropriate.

Capital Campaign

The Capital Campaign continues to go well. Once new gifts are announced, the Principal will be able to provide an overall update on financial results.

Canadian Interuniversity Sport (CIS)

The organisation governing Canadian Interuniversity Sport (CIS) has been restructured. The Principal represents Quebec on the new board, which is made up of University Presidents and Athletics Directors. The Principal reported that he was encouraged by the meeting he had attended because he sensed that other members of the Board shared Bishop's values.

Financial Challenges

Bishop's has budgeted a \$4.5 deficit for 2015-16. The administration is in discussions with the A.P.B.U. on the composition and mandate of a task force made up of faculty and administrators to look at all of the University's finances, and to develop solutions to make the university sustainable. The Task Force's

recommendations will be shared with Senate and the Board, as well as the A.P.B.U., the administration and Faculty Council.

Donald Lecture Series

The Principal reminded everyone that Royal Orr would be interviewing Edward Snowden on November 3rd, and encouraged Senators to attend.

ITEM 572/4 BUSINESS ARISING

4.1 Mandate of the E-Learning Sub-Committee of the Continuing Education Committee

Associate Vice-Principal Continuing Education Marie-Josée Berger reported that the E-learning Sub-Committee had met and discussed the mandate, rationale and timeline for its work. She moved the approval of the composition and mandate of the Sub-Committee, and Laurie Milner seconded the motion.

The motion carried.

Mandate of the E-Learning Committee

The e-Learning Committee will provide guidance on the use of technology, in enhancing the quality of teaching and learning, and the overall academic experience of Bishop's students. An effective e-Learning strategy must enable Bishop's to leverage its traditional strengths for on-campus students as well as for distance learners.

Rationale for the mandate

- e-Learning has been integrated into the core teaching and learning activities of almost all Canadian Universities;
- e-Learning represents an opportunity to broaden Bishop's reach and horizons;
- e-Learning will allow Bishop's University to make learning accessible to students with various needs, which represents today's reality;
- e-Learning requires IT infrastructures and instruction development that supports both Faculty and Contract Faculty.

Timeline

- November: Second e-Learning Committee meeting
- December: Third e-Learning Committee meeting (before exams)
- January: Deadline for e-Learning Report to Senate

Composition of the E-learning Committee

During the course of discussion, Senators raised several issues related to an elearning strategy: the target market for these courses, numbers of students that we expect will register in them, availability on and off campus and the cost of offering them. It was suggested that business students could help with the analyses necessary to understand the break-even point for this model.

Vice-Principal Academic Miles Turnbull moved that Senate endorse the allocation of five part-time credits to pilot delivering up to five existing courses on-line in spring 2015. Senate Planning Committee would be charged with deciding which courses they will be. Hafid Agourram seconded the motion. It was seconded by Hafid Aggouram.

The motion carried, two opposed, one abstention.

4.2 Timetable for the Senate Program Academic Review Committee (SPARC)

Vice-Principal Turnbull reported that he had informed the departments on the academic review list for 2014-15 that the process will resume. The Schedule will be made available within a month.

4.3 Definition of certificate programs

There is concern regarding a lack of definition or framing of certificate programs. The number of credits per certificate program varies depending on whether it is offered at the undergraduate or graduate level. There is a need to establish a definition section in the General Contents section of the Academic Calendar which would include certificate programs.

The Vice-Principal Academic moved that the Academic Standing and Admissions Policy Committee be tasked with developing a definition of certificate programs for inclusion in the Academic Calendar. The Committee would consult with faculty from the different Divisions in developing the definition, and bring it back to Senate for approval. Jean Manore seconded the motion.

The motion carried.

Chelsea McLellan, V.P. Academic of the Students' Representative Council, noted that other elements of the calendar should be clarified as well, and that, in the interim, the SRC was looking at training 'peer interpreters' of the calendar to assist students. The Principal asked Ms McLellan to consult on a process to achieve this and come back to Senate with a recommendation.

5.2 Report of Senate Research Committee on Bishop's Canada Research Chairs

Vice-Principal Turnbull reported that there is currently one vacant Canada Research Chair at Bishop's and that a second will be vacant as of June 30th.

A Chair will be allocated to each of the Star Cluster and the Psychological Health and Well-being (PHWB) Cluster.

The membership of the Selection Committees is as follows:

- For the Star Cluster Chair, Lorne Nelson, Estelle Chamoux the Vice Principal Academic and the Dean of Arts and Science;
- For Psychological Health and Well-being: Dale Stout, Chair of Psychology, will chair the committee, which will include: Maxime Trempe, Christopher Stonebanks, the Dean of Arts & Science and the Vice Principal Academic.

Applications for the Canada Research Chairs will be submitted either in April of 2016 or in the fall of that year.

5.3 Update from the Chair of Senate Planning Committee on tenure-stream faculty positions

The Senate Planning Committee had received submissions for tenure-stream positions and had done an initial ranking. The list would be shared with Departmental Chairs and presented at the November 16th Senate meeting.

5.4 Senate Planning Committee: changes to the part-time request forms

In response to questions raised about the meaning of 'mandatory' on the parttime request form, the Vice-Principal Academic informed Senate that the form will be revised.

Dr. Turnbull distributed a snap shot of the size of courses in 2014-15 and informed Senate that the current academic offerings will not all be able to be maintained next year if we are to make our model sustainable.

Dean Murray moved that the Senate approve offering this course again if funding is available and Hafid Agourram seconded the motion.
