


main lobby.... spectator level


The stairs on your right lead to the participants' level, locker rooms and other all purpose rooms. On the right of the stairs is a hallway leading to the physical education and information offices.

Here are the men's and women's locker rooms; men's and women's saunas; team dressing rooms for football, soccer and basketball; six regulation squash courts, and a large weight training room.

Hair dryers will also be standard equipment.


swimming pool

The 6-lane pool is 25 meters in length. A three meter diving board and five meter diving platform complete this facility, with seating capacity for 200 people.

large gymnasium

This will be the centre of most of the complex's activities. The bleachers to your centre and right are part of an overall seating plan capable of handling 3,000 spectators. Some of the bleachers are portable.

The gym measures 120' x 104' and has a "tartan" floor, with space for two regulation basketball courts, three regulation volleyball courts, eight regulation badminton courts and two regulation indoor tennis courts.




